Special Announcement: The Need is Real and Urgent!

SNAP benefits were needlessly cancelled by the Trump administration on November 1st and while they are reportedly being restored from contingency funds, the need for more assistance is indeed real and urgent. Rising unemployment and higher prices on food and other expenses increases the burden on families and reduces their ability to make ends meet, increasing the demand on food pantries. As of this writing, the Trump Administration says they will restore SNAP benefits as directed by two federal judges, but the amounts will be reduced by half and will be delayed by a week or more depending on states' ability to process the adjusted amounts. Article:SNAP benefits will restart, but will be half the normal payment and delayed.

The MCDCC is stepping up to help in this uncertain time. We have placed a donation box in our office and are encouraging visitors to drop off non-perishable food items (unexpired canned goods, pasta, rice, nut butters, and other shelf-stable items). If you are able to donate money, it is also needed in greater amounts at this time. Fresh produce and other perishable food items must often be purchased and the infrastructure for food collection and distribution must be supported.
