Oregon state legislator Cyrus Javadi has switched parties to become a Democrat, saying the GOP is more interested in "burning things down" than governing for its constituents. Rep. Javadi made the announcement on Substack confirming he will seek reelection on the Democratic ticket next year. His party swap increases the Oregon House's Democratic majority to 37 seats out of 60.
